Welcome to this year's CPDL brochure

As part of our vision to enable all to flourish and in line with the Trust's strategic plan, we have developed a wide range of learning opportunities to support you in your work whether you are involved in teaching and learning, governance, administration, premises or finance.

We are delighted that, in addition to our central team, skilled staff from across the Trust schools are delivering training. This celebrates the fantastic talents we have across our family exemplifying how we are stronger when we work together and share good practice.

We are also pleased to continue to partner with some external professionals, well known to the organisation, to support our training offer. Helen Tate, Steve Lomax and Nicki Cunningham Smith are delivering training for leaders this year. In addition, following the closure of the computing hubs, we are partnering with the University of Gloucester to deliver the ICT leaders' group, this will ensure that we are supported with the latest thinking and knowledge for the delivery of ICT within our schools. Action research will continue in order to develop our pedagogical knowledge and understanding including the use of Teacher Walk Thru's, building on last year's excellent grounding. We are also hoping to work with a new partner Envesca to support us with compliance training. In addition to the courses run centrally, we are also blessed through our PiXL membership to add additional leadership courses run by PiXL as part of our subscription.

Having listened to the feedback from our inset day, we have scheduled regular opportunities throughout the year for Subject Leader groups to meet and collaborate and introduce more training around oracy skills.

For those involved in governance there is an extensive offer of training for both new and experienced governors. Clerks can continue to access training and support through the regular forum meetings. Chairs group meetings continue to offer the opportunity for Chair of Governors to network, share good practice and feedback to the Trust Board.

Administrative, premises and finance staff can benefit from the regular group training sessions and this year we are introducing some support for the management of trips and the completion of the census.

New this year is the introduction of a series of short, recorded sessions. In the first instance these will be related to teaching and learning pedagogy but will extend into other areas such as governance and finance as the year progresses. These sessions are all stored on our Trust website.

Please spend a little time considering what would interest you and support you to flourish next year.

As always our training is split into CORE, KEY and OPTIONAL training:

Core: events and training where attendance from each school is expected,

Key: is important, attendance from each school is strongly encouraged to
ensure key messages and support are shared and heard,

Optional: exactly that - optional. Each school to attend if it is of interest or is relevant.

In addition to the courses outlined in this brochure we will respond to any needs as they arise. Details of these will be emailed out to schools. If there is something that you feel is missing from our current offer or you would like something bespoke for your school, please contact Helen (hspringett@cen.dgat.org.uk) to discuss this further.




