The Phonics for SEN programme enables pupils with a range of special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) to find success with reading and spelling. It is suitable for pupils of all ages with SEN, including specific learning difficulties, autism, moderate and severe learning difficulties, sensory needs, developmental language disorder, communication needs and complex needs, including pre- and nonverbal pupils and those with significant physical disabilities.

#### **Phonics for SEN:**

- is a complete programme for teaching reading and spelling,
- is systematic (covering all 44 sounds),
- is synthetic phonics (building words from their smallest components phonemes and graphemes),
- is linguistic phonics (focusing on the sound first and then the graphemes that represent them),
- builds knowledge incrementally,
- teaches the key skills of blending, segmenting and phoneme manipulation,
- works at code, word, sentence and text level throughout,
- is accessible for pupils with a range of additional needs.





### **Decodable Readers**

Phonics for SEN offers several series of decodable readers. These match to the teaching sequence of the programme (all the sets, word structures and sounds) and spans Books  $\mathbf{1} - \mathbf{6}$  of the core books.

The engaging stories follow the adventures of a family - Mum, Dad, Dan and Mim and their naughty pets, Pat the dog and Tim the cat. In later books we meet Gran and Dan and Mim's friends, Ravi and Nola, who join in the fun. Stories and illustrations are age neutral.




# Why Phonics for SEN?

Phonics for SEN is specifically written for pupils with moderate to severe and complex special educational needs. The programme is used as an intervention in mainstream schools and as a programme for initial instruction in specialist schools.




## **Training**

As well as the training package, schools also receive lots of supplementary resources, including:
