SPEAKERS

Focus: Developing pupils' spoken language, specifically the order of words in simple spoken sentences or syntax.

Activities: Colourful
Sentences (colour-coded
picture cards, related to a
question prompt used to
build oral sentences), The Big
Scene and Silly Sentences.

Suitable for: Pupils with language and communication needs and EAL learners.



READERS

Focus: All aspects of readingdecoding, language structure, reading comprehension, vocabulary and background knowledge.

Activities: Matched to phonics sets 1-7: Decodable Reader, Fact File, Sentence Builder, Colourful Sentences, The Big Scene, Vocabulary Builder and Prime Words.

Suitable for: Pupils with Special Educational Needs (SEN) / Additional Learning Needs (ALN).



WRITERS

Focus: All aspects of writingletter formation, single word spelling, writing sentences, writing a story and creating a book.

Activities: Matched to phonics sets 1-7: Letter Chart, Letter Formation, Match upper and lower case letters, Word Build, Spelling Practice, Building Sentences, Dictated Sentences, Scaffolded Story and Producing a Book.

Suitable for: Pupils with Special Educational Needs (SEN) / Additional Learning Needs (ALN).



THINKERS

Focus: Reading single words, phrases, sentences and text with the use of simple strategies (provided) to enable access.

Activities: Matched to phonics sets 1-7: Three different sets of Decodable Readers, Fact Files, Matching Words and Pictures and Matching Phrases and Pictures.

Suitable for: Pupils who are pre- or nonverbal, with or without Special Educational Needs (SEN) / Additional Learning Needs (ALN).
